## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY DURING COVID-19

If you have or are currently:

- Unwell / Had a cough and/or Fever
- Been in contact with someone unwell in the last 2 weeks

Please let us know - at this point we may need to ask you to not attend rehearsal. SCYWO does reserve the right to ask anyone to leave rehearsal as needed.

Hand sanitiser is provided in several locations. We ask that you please make use of this as you enter and before you touch any communal surfaces.

As you enter the venue, please move directly into the rehearsal space. During this time, we are restricting access to only the rehearsal space, toilets and exits. If you have any concerns with the facilities (heating, seating, cupboard access, equipment, etc.) please ask a committee member for assistance to help us reduce touch-points.

At the first rehearsal you attend, the committee will provide you with a folder of music and a pencil. If you do not bring your own stand, you will also be provided with a stand.

These loaned items will be yours to hold onto for the time being. Please bring these to each rehearsal - we will not have spares.

You are asked during this time to not share these items (or other items like instruments) with any others.

Please bring your own water bottle, spit cloth, valve oil, reeds or other consumables.

Where possible, please keep your belongings (bag, instrument case, etc) under / next your chair.

Please do not bring food into the venue. The kitchen will be out of bounds at this time.

We request that only band members enter the building.

Rehearsal will now be 7:00pm to 8:45pm. Band members may only enter from 6:45pm, and must leave by 9:00pm. There will be no break at this point.

The committee will be working before and after these times to clean the rehearsal space.

Before and after rehearsal, we request that you do not loiter as a group on the venue grounds in line with government guidelines.

Carpooling is not currently recommended.

The COVIDSafe app is recommended for those with an appropriate device.
